The rarest of all whales continues to drift towards extinction and the causes of their decline remain both poorly understood and difficult to manage. The discoveries of PCCS marine scientists and the mysteries that envelop the gradual extinction of right whales will be explored. Through this illustrated presentation, a PCCS scientist will describe the interaction of right whales with their food and the impact of global climate change on their delicate marine habitats. The latest studies of the relationships between Cape Cod Bay, whales that visit each winter, and the larger issues of conservation of rare marine mammals will also be discussed.
