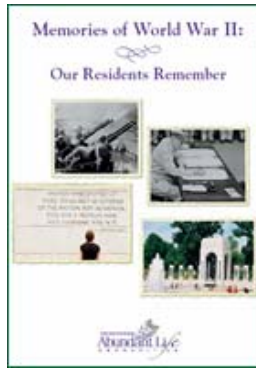
In almost every case, the person being interviewed would start off by saying “***Well, I didn’t really do anything***” and then would go on to tell the most amazing stories.
